CLAIM OF APPEAL

1. Intervenor **ENVIRONMENTAL LAW & POLICY CENTER** and **MICHIGAN CLIMATE ACTION NETWORK** claim an appeal from the final order of the Michigan Public Service Commission (“MPSC”) entered on December 1, 2023 in the above-captioned matter (Exhibit A). The appeal is brought under MCL 462.26, and claims the MPSC’s December 1, 2023 order is contrary to Act 16, 1929 PA 16, MCL 483.1 *et seq.*, and the Michigan Environmental Protection Act (“MEPA”), MCL 324.1701-.1706.
